## STAFF SPOTLIGHT

The *Public Works Director*, Patrick Moore, is responsible for supervising all activities completed by the Public Works Department, animal control and Town vehicle maintenance.

The *Building and Grounds Maintenance Technicians*, Tony Riley, and Kleber Aguilar are responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of Town owned properties and streets. They perform maintenance, installation, and repairs of street signs, grounds keeping, and debris removal, and housekeeping functions such as painting, replacing filters, replacing light bulbs, light cleaning.

The Wilson's Mills Public Works Department strives to maintain the safe passage, as well as the high quality and functionality of Town streets and street signs. The Street Department is responsible for over 10 miles of Town maintained streets, and street signs.

# OCTOBER IS FIRE PREVENTION MONTH IS YOUR HOME PREPARED IN CASE OF A FIRE?

Roughly three out of five fire deaths happen in homes with either no smoke alarms or no working smoke alarms. Smoke alarms are the first line of defense in a home fire, but they need to be working to protect you. These three actions will ensure your smoke alarms are working for you and your family.

## INSTALL

Install smoke alarms in every bedroom, outside each separate sleeping area (like a hallway), and on each level (including the basement) of the home.

## TEST

Test smoke alarms at least once a month by pushing the test button.

## REPLACE

Replace all smoke alarms when they are 10 years old or stop responding when tested.

## FOOD INSECURITIES IN WILSON'S MILLS

How are we helping?

Our Share Shed is an accessible storage container that houses donated items with the objective of providing assistance to families suffering with food insecurities.

What's inside?

Non-perishable food such as canned, boxed, and prepackaged goods that do not require refrigeration; toiletries such as shampoo, conditioner, soaps, dental hygiene products, paper products; and seasonal items such as blankets in the winter and sunscreen in the summer.

How can I help?

We accept donations at Town Hall Monday - Friday, 8:30 am - 5:00 pm; OR items can be left neatly inside the share shed 24/7.

My family is in need, how do I access the Share Shed?

The Share Shed is accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. We kindly ask that you do not take more than necessary, so that everyone in need may benefit.
